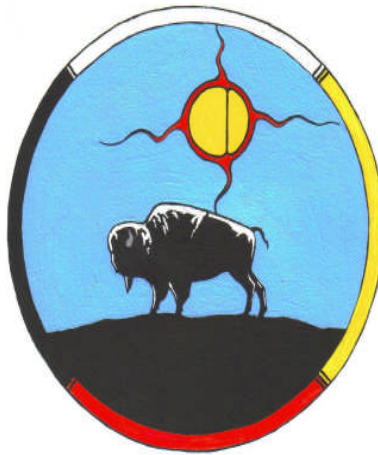


## ABORIGINAL FINANCIAL OFFICERS ASSOCIATION OF MANITOBA, INC.
